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Infierno, canto I: alegoría de la selva

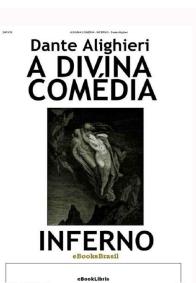
El canto I de "La Divina Comedia" pertenece a la cántica del Infierno aunque no se encuentra dentro de él ya que el mundo subterráneo de la muerte comienza en el canto III. El canto I funciona como introducción tanto para el mundo infernal como para toda la obra en general.

Dante personaje se presenta al inicio de su poema-narrativo perdido "en una selva oscura". Plantea una metáfora bíblica para referirse a la vida: "camino de nuestra vida", él se halla en la mitad, por lo tanto, los estudiosos establecieron los 35 años como la edad aproximada que debe tener el personaje. La "selva" es una fuerte imagen metafórica que representa el pecado no sólo por la oscuridad a la que no llega la luz del sol y la razón, sino también por sus tres significativas carcaterísticas: "tupida, áspera y salvaje", es díficil encontrar la salida y dificil su estancia en ella. La razón por la que protagonista se encuentra en ese lugar hace referencia a otra metáfora de uso bíblico: "la buena senda" que Dante-personaje había perdido. La selva, como vida pecadora, llega en el momento en que el individuo se aleja de vida correcta desde un punto de vista moral. El buen camino es la existencia que respeta los preceptos o mandamientos, en este caso, cristianos.

Tan sólo recordar esa experiencia, vuelve tan real el sentimiento de "pavor" en el personaje como si estuviera de vuelta allí, el pasaje por esa "selva" dejó huellas profundas en el alma de Dante que se siente cercano al fin de sólo pensar en ello. En este momento, se establece el comienzo de la historia ya que el protagonista plantea que contará lo que vio en su experiencia con el fin de comunicar "el bien" que encontró allí. En este caso, la circunstancia adversa y dolorosa, depara un conocimiento o aprendizaje fructifero.

El narrador no tiene la claridad necesaria para explicar el modo en que entró en el pecado, el sueño es el estado del espíritu que se asocia al inconsciente, por lo tanto el personaje estaba dominado por el sueño cuando cae en la vida impía, es decir, en estado inconsciente, sin controlar sus impulsos o instintos. Cuando logra llegar al borde del "valle" que lo llenó de "espanto" se encontró "al pie de una colina", esta es asociada con el monte del Purgatorio, el reino donde esperan purificarse aquellos que subirán al Paraíso. Como la "cumbre" de este monte tiene la luz del sol, que en tiempo de Dante se pensaba que era un planeta, se puede identificar su cima con el paraíso terrenal donde comienza la luz de los bienaventurados.

Dante establece una imagen metafórica a través del "lago de mi corazón" para expresar el sitio más íntimo y frágil en el interior del ser humano. Los sentimientos agitados del corazón del protagonista,

Introducción

La Divina Comedia podria catalogarse probablemente como una epopeya escrita en formato de poema y lo primero que destaca en su relato es el carácter alegórico de la composición. Por ejemplo en el canto I del infierno tenemos a una pantera o leopardo representando la lujuria, al león representando la soberbia o el orgullo y a una loba representando la codicia o avaricia. Otro ejemplo es la presencia del número 3, que simboliza a la Santísima Trinidad y además son tres las fieras que se le aparecen a Dante en la selva oscura, son tres los reinos que atraviesa Dante, tres los rostros de Lucifer, etc.

Tampoco escapa a nuestra percepción la finalidad religiosa de la obra. La efervescencia religiosa era grande en la época de Dante y él parece pretender que la lectura de su comedia llegue a inducir en los lectores, un verdadero temor al pecado y que eso los lleve a apartarse de la senda del mal y optar por el camino de la virtud y el bien.

Considerada una de las grandes obras de la literatura universal, la Divina Comedia plantea un esquema del destino humano que consta de dogmática propia de la época, una dogmática mayormente cristiana pero con evidentes toques de mitología grecolatina y mística de origen oriental, mesclada con un mundo matemático que probablemente merece un estudio especial. Los terribles castigos que esperaban a las almas condenadas y los horrores del infierno, hacen uso de otros recursos habituales de la época, como los bestiarios medievales: que eran representaciones de seres, muchos de ellos monstruosos y que se utilizaban frecuentemente en la decoración de los templos y las ilustraciones temáticas.
